We have now secured the use of Destiny Ranch in Grass Valley situated on 50 acres. Destiny Ranch is not a public facility and dedicated solely to equine rescue. Currently we have 12 horses at the ranch, including a month old orphaned paint foal named "Tonka Toy" (shown below right). All other residents are TB's except for a Morgan (Paris) and a QH cross (Bambi).



Recently, although only one mare, "Pieces of Paradise" (Dice) was expected to be transported to the ranch, four horses were on the truck. "Dark Nose" (Brownie), (shown above left), is a six year old gelding who is lame on 3 legs, has locking kneecap syndrome, an old bow, a sore check ligament and a potential stifle problem. Although Brownie has many severe medical issues the attending vet does think he could recover with proper medical care and a long rehabilitation period. Dark Nose is in dire need of sponsorship. Please consider helping him. He still has a tremendous will to live and is a grateful and cooperative patient.
